Dear Parents and Staff,

Providing a safe and healthy learning environment is a top priority for the Technology Center of DuPage. Ensuring that our drinking water is clean and safe for consumption is one of the ways we can achieve that goal.

Technology Center of DuPage elected to complete voluntary water testing as outlined by Illinois Public Act 099-092. This Act requires all public and private school buildings built between 1987 and 2000, and occupied by more than ten students in grades preschool through fifth grade, to test all sources of potable water for lead. TCD was constructed in 1973.

The most recent testing took place in January of 2021. Water samples from thirty water sources were collected. The samples were evaluated at Suburban Laboratories, Inc., an Illinois EPA and IDPH certified testing facility.

Lead was either not detected or was below the IDPH guideline of five ppb (parts per billion) in all water samples collected. As an ongoing preventive measure, all water sources are flushed daily.
