DAOES is organized and operates as an Intergovernmental Agreement to Constitute the DuPage Area Occupational Education System for the operation of the DuPage Area Vocational Education Authority (DAVEA) serving the needs of children in grades 11 and 12 and others as required by the School Code.

Non-Member School Districts

The DAOES Board of Directors will consider requests from non-member school districts to contract for Technology Center of DuPage instructional services on a space-available basis.

Such contracts will include an assessment for maintenance and/or depreciation to be added to the usual assessment for current operating costs. Inquiries must be directed to the DAOES Director.
