

IMPORTANT SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE

First Annual Samuel T. Watts Fire Science Scholarship

The College of DuPage EMS/Fire Science program has established the Samuel T. Watts Fire Science Scholarship, which will first be awarded in the Fall of 2013, to two students training in the EMS/Firefighting Profession. There are two scholarships, each in the amount of \$2,500, to be awarded.

Scholarship application deadline: April 1, 2013

The scholarship was established in memory of Technology Center of DuPage Fire Science alum Samuel Watts ('10). Watts died in May 2012 as the result of wounds he sustained while on patrol in Afghanistan, where he was serving his country in the United States Army. Watts had intended to continue his education in Fire Science after his military service.

Scholarship Criteria:

District 502 (College of DuPage) resident

Currently enrolled in College of DuPage and a dual credit Fire Science program (e.g. TCD Fire Science)

3.0 or higher GPA

Two letters of recommendation from non-COD / Dual Credit personnel

One page essay explaining career goals and objectives

Financial need may also be considered
